

How to Measure



Understanding the setup: Over 90% of wooden gates are fitted with the hinges being mounted on the rear of the posts. The gate then sits between the posts with the rear edge of the gate inline with the rear of the posts.

Measuring between existing posts/ pillars:

Take three horizontal measurements between the posts/ pillars. Top, middle and bottom.

TOP =

MIDDLE =

BOTTOM =

Take the smallest size, reduce by 20mm ($3/4$ ") to allow for gap clearance. Size you are left with is the width of gate required.

If ordering online, use the drop-down box and select the closest size (smaller) or call to order exact size (0800 6124 965).

Measuring without posts/ pillars:

Simply take the complete width. Decide your post size (either 3" x 2", 3" x 3" or 4" x 4"), minus the posts then reduce by 20mm ($3/4$ ").
